**AGREED ORDER CONTINUING HEARING,  
STIPULATING TO ADVERSARY RULES  
AND FOR ENTRY OF SCHEDULING ORDER REGARDING,  
LAW & PARHAM  
(CLAIM NOS. 1640-1647, 1871)**

On the 18<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2011, came before the Court the Litigation Trustee's Objection to Claims of J. Alexander Law, Jr. and Lewis H. Parham, Jr. ("Law & Parham") (Claim Nos. 1640, 1641, 1642, 1643, 1644, 1645, 1646, 1647 and 1871) (Doc #1370). Counsel for the Litigation Trust, for the Reorganized Debtors, and for Law & Parham announced to the court that additional pleadings are necessary to set forth the disputes of the parties, that it is stipulated that the parties to this dispute will be bound by Bankruptcy Rules 7001, et seq., as well as the Local Rules of this court relating to adversary proceedings, and that the scheduling order set forth below should be entered. It is, therefore,

**ORDERED** that the hearing on the Litigation Trustee's Objection to Claims of Law & Parham (Claim Nos. 1640, 1641, 1642, 1643, 1644, 1645, 1646, 1647 and 1871, "the Law & Parham Claims") is continued until a later date to be set by the court. It is further

**ORDERED** that the parties to this order have stipulated that the litigation of this matter shall be governed by the provisions of Bankruptcy Rules 7001, et seq., and the Local Rules of this court which relate to adversary proceedings, which stipulation is approved. It is further


**ORDERED** that the parties shall be bound by the following deadlines:

1. **Amended Objection/Adversary Action.** Litigation Trust must file an amended objection to the Law & Parham Claims, including any causes of action seeking to recharacterize the agreements under which the Law & Parham Claims arose, on or before **March 7, 2011**;
2. **Law & Parham Responsive Pleadings.** Law & Parham must file a response to each of the pleadings filed by the Litigation Trust, as set forth above, on or before **March 21, 2011**;
3. **Discovery.** Unless the parties agree otherwise, no discovery may be served until Law & Parham has filed responsive pleadings, and all discovery shall be completed on or before **May 20, 2011**;
4. **Dispositive Motions.** Any dispositive motions must be filed on or before **May 31, 2011**, and any response to dispositive motions must be filed on or before **June 20, 2011**.
5. **Pre-Trial Order.** The parties shall submit an agreed pre-trial order on or before **July 1, 2011**;
6. **Pre-Trial Conference and/or Pre-Trial Docket Call.** A pre-trial conference and/or pre-trial docket call on this matter will be held on the date(s) set forth by the Court above.



